Obtaining a Handicap

For those who do not have a recognised handicap, you must be deemed proficient by one of the Club's Professionals. Until a handicap is obtained you will not be able to tee off before 12.30 on weekends.

Thereafter, in order to obtain a handicap you will be required to submit three cards of 18 holes from Stoke Park only. These will need to be signed by your playing partner, of who does not have to be a member of the Club, neither do they have to have a handicap. These cards should be handed into a member of staff in the Golf Office situated in the Pro Shop.

Upon joining the Club, new Members may transfer their handicap from their previous Club so long as it is within the UK. Those with overseas handicaps shall have to go through the process listed above.

Active/Inactive Handicaps

The English Golf Union and English Women's Golf Association are launching a system that identifies the competitive nature of all members with a CONGU handicap.

As of January 2010, all members will be required to have submitted 3 qualifying scores (including Supplementary Scores & 9 Hole Qualifying Competitions and Away scores) during the calendar year 2009, to avoid having an inactive handicap for the playing season, 2010. Should anyone wish to hand in supplementary scores before the end of the year in order to keep their handicap active, the Supplementary Score Book is located in the Pro Shop, in which you must sign before you go out and play.

Clubs will be permitted to exempt players from an inactive (*i*) handicap for injury/illness that has prevented them from achieving the required number of qualifying scores during a calendar year. This will also include those players who are transferring membership who have submitted scores albeit at another Club and to golfers new to the game who are being issued with first CONGU handicap.

Members who have become inactive will be required to return three qualifying scores before the indicator on the handicap system is removed. Qualifying scores of less than 3 are not permitted to be carried over to the next year, i.e. no topping up of qualifying scores permitted, e.g. 1 score in the previous year and 2 in current year.

Stoke Park has imposed an entry condition that requires an active handicap (3 previously submitted qualifying scores) for specific competitions only which are all qualifying competitions including trophy and boarded events. In all other cases Stoke Park will allow "home" players with inactive handicaps entry to qualifying competitions in order to provide as much opportunity as possible for the removal of the inactive handicap with the exclusion of winning any prize money.

An inactive handicap can still be used for social golf and those competitions for which an active handicap is not an entry condition. Scores from players with inactive handicaps will be used in the calculation of a CSS. The active/inactive identification of handicaps will be required as from the beginning of 2010.

Club Competitions

All Club competitions are posted on the Competition Notice Boards throughout the year. The men's events are situated in the corridor between the Club Shop and Changing Rooms and also on the board in the Pro Shop.

Ladies' events are displayed in the Ladies Changing Rooms.

All events require an official handicap to participate. Please feel free to sign up to any of these events or if you have any questions, please speak to a member of the Golf Team.

You do not need to book to participate in the Roll Up. Should you be looking for a game of golf, this is the perfect opportunity for you to come and meet many of the Clubs more regular Members.

Please note that there are no Roll Up times booked when a Club competition is taking place.

Etiquette

No arrangements to accommodate a large number of players can succeed without the goodwill of all, and one slow match can spoil the round for others. If you lose your ball please look for it yourself and insist upon others playing on.

Please replace divot marks, repair pitch marks on greens and smooth bunkers.

Practice may only take place on the designated practice areas.

Please note that only Soft Spikes only are to be worn on the course.
